### **Chaperone Expectations**

The following information is for adult chaperones that will accompany participants during the 2011 CyberSummit, taking place April 21<sup>st</sup> and 22<sup>nd</sup> at our Blue Hill Club. This information will provide more detail regarding events and expectations over the two-day period in order to create an enjoyable experience for all participating.

#### **Check In and Workshops**

- Please check in first, collect nametags, workshop assignments, receive any updated information and then unload luggage from vehicles.
- Adults are expected to attend workshops and/or volunteer in areas that need adult support and supervision.
- Please provide a list of names of adult chaperones with submission of participant registration forms.

#### **Challenge Teams**

- All participants are divided equally into various "challenge" teams. These team assignments are not to be changed unless otherwise directed by the conference coordinator.
- Participating adults will be asked to support teams during their team meetings. A brief orientation will take place during the first day for adults.

#### **Meals**

- Continental breakfast, lunch, dinner, and snacks will be provided. Please help participants keep areas clean.
- Food is only allowed in designated areas.
- Any additional food/snacks brought by groups will be stored in the kitchen and may be refrigerated.

#### **Accommodations**

- Sleeping bags or bedrolls will be needed for the sleepover. Sleeping accommodations will be on the floor.
- Male and female participants will have divided sleeping areas. Adult chaperones will be divided accordingly into sleeping areas.
- Showers are available.

#### **Activities**
